The Keirin - The race originated in Japan as a way to have paramutaul sports betting after World War II. The rules have changed quite a bit over the years and what was once a very physical type of racing is now quite straight forward and good event for new riders as well as veteran racers. The riders draw for start position and once the race begins they will draft behind the “motor” in those same positions for the first half of the race. After the motor swings off, the race is on. The motor keeps the field together and brings the riders up to speed. Tactics, positioning, drafting as well as speed and power all play a role in this fun type of racing.



Who

This series is open to all BVV Certified riders.
No USA Cycling license required to participate.

Format

Riders compete in a flying 1 Lap TT; then seeded based upon time and placed into groups of similar times. Riders may be moved up or down in groups after heats. The goal is for all riders to get 3 Keirin races in during the session.
